

DBF, Patience and Stones Cry Out ministry involvement in the new school

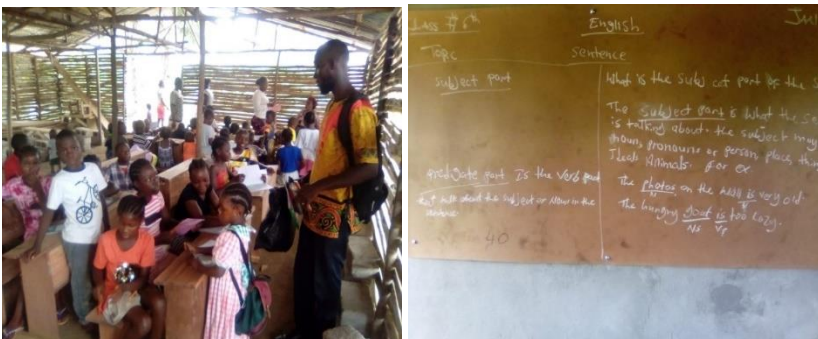
The Liberian Christians and even some Muslims living in the bush consider this “free” school an obvious work of God. In the middle of nowhere, a building suddenly appeared. It was not funded by a large philanthropic organization but by individual Christians moved by the Spirit to give spontaneously. In the beginning of 2021, even when the building was not completely finished, classes began and the work continued. The people in the area recognized that it was a work of genuine love. Hundreds of children sought the opportunity to attend, including some with Christian backgrounds and some with Muslim backgrounds. After graduation, work continued on the building. Below are pictures of the construction of a new bathroom building and a well that were completed in August 2021.



During the summer of 2021, doors were also installed on the main building to keep animals and other unwanted guests out. Also, a wall is being constructed around the entire property to keep unwanted snakes and other animals out and safeguard little children from wandering too far from the school. Maybe it should be called Ezra's wall but then again, everything that has been constructed on the property was brought about by the God of Ezra in the same powerful way.

Future projects: After the wall, and as the Lord provides, another classroom is planned that will allow school beyond the 8th grade. There is also a desire to install lighting and a generator that will allow adult learn-to-read classes at night.

Pray that God moves His people to provide for these two needs (wall and additional classroom.) Also, the total of monthly salaries for the teachers is about \$ 400 U.S. funds. (There are at least 8 teachers.) This is an ongoing need.
